







THE BIBLIOGRAPHICAL TEST

HAS THE BIBLE REALLY BEEN PRESERVED FOR US TODAY?

When we examine the number and quality of manuscripts available, and the gap of time between the original and the earliest existing copies, there is overwhelming evidence that the text of the New Testament we have today is the same as the original. If an individual rejects the transmissional reliability of the New Testament throughout history then they must consider other works throughout history to also be unreliable.






"For over 99 percent of the words of the Bible, we know what the original manuscript said. Even for many of the verses where there are textual variants (that is, different words in different ancient copies of the same verse), the correct decision is clear, and there are very few places where the textual variant is both difficult to evaluate and significant in determining the meaning."
